No one is going to port DLR to any place. Once the 1.02 code base was lost that ended any chance of the game ever getting ported anyplace. As much as we all love the game it's 20 years old now and the players that played it are all in a different phase of life (45-60 years old) and likely not playing nearly as many games as they used to (I know I don't).

Android (phone based) strategy games look quite different that DLR interface wise and practically none are head-2-head live like DLR was. That's still the realm of PC/XBox.
