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I recommend The Battle for Wesnoth, primarily because it is explicitly designed to be highly user-customizable. You can very easily create not only new units, scenarios and campaigns, but also add new abilities/spells which are not part of the core game. It also allows for branching campaigns and complex in-scenario events which occur when specific conditions are met and which may be dependent on player choices (something noticeably lacking from DLR!)

Customization does involve learning WML, a purpose-designed markup language, but frankly if I can figure it out, anybody can!

There's also a very large and active community surrounding the game (over 20,000 forum members, many of whom actively develop new game content). It's a free download, so it's well worth looking into.

That sounded a bit more like an advert than I intended...

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
